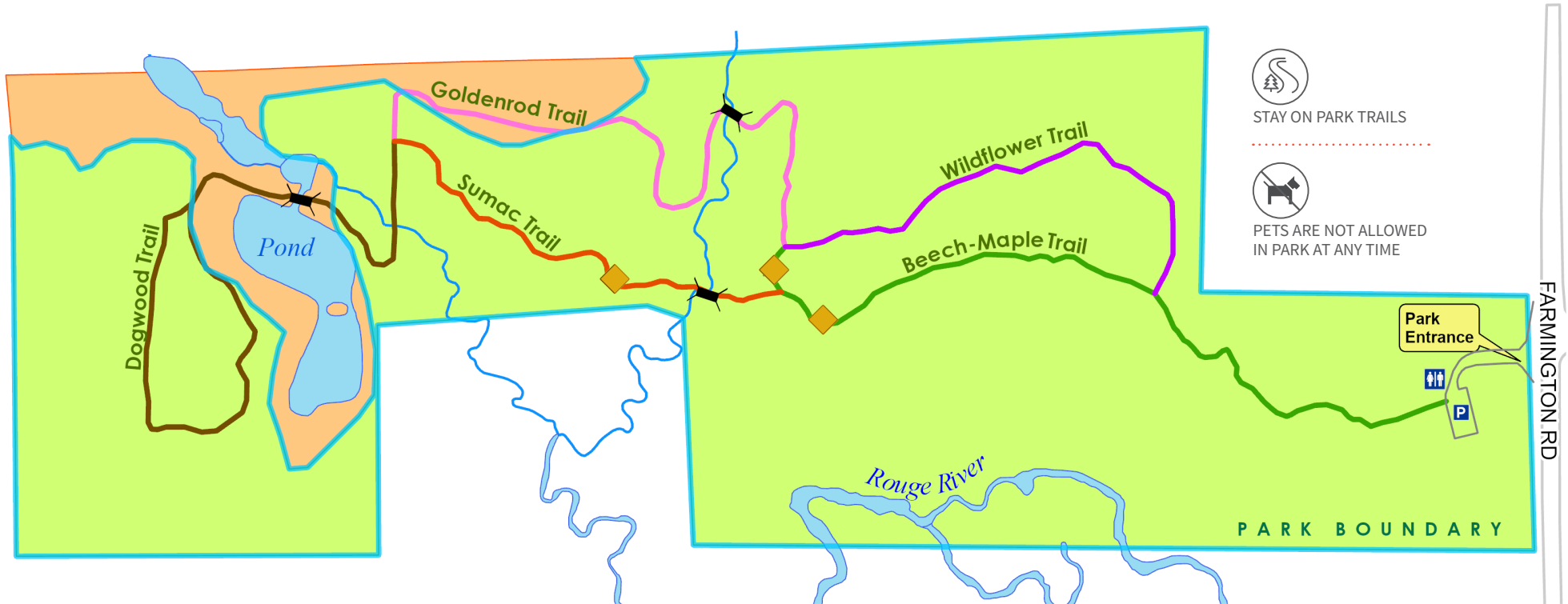

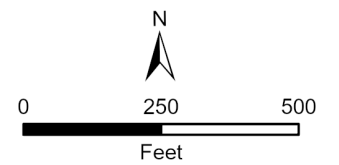


- STAY ON PARK TRAILS
