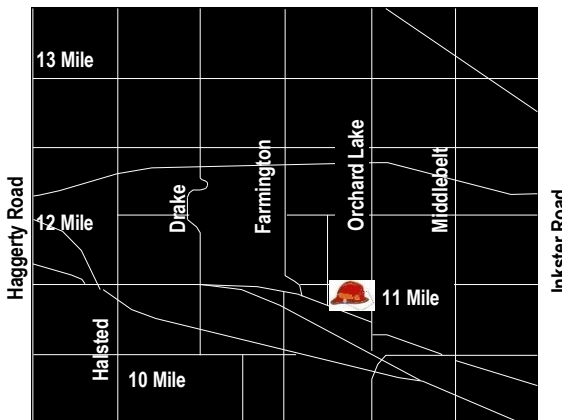

PAID-ON-CALL (PART TIME) FIREFIGHTER QUALIFICATIONS

- ✘ Authorized to work in the U.S.
- ✘ 18 years of age or older
- ✘ High School graduate or equivalent
- ✘ Valid Michigan driver's license
- ✘ A good driving record
- ✘ No criminal convictions
- ✘ Satisfactory employment record
- ✘ Pass Physical Ability Test
- ✘ Pass Department Physical Examination
- ✘ Pass Psychological Examination
- ✘ Training and responding to calls takes place in the evenings and the weekends. The majority of Paid-on-Call Fire Fighters work full-time jobs and/or go to school in addition to being a Paid-on-Call Firefighter.

Firefighter I & II certificates and an EMT-Basic license are NOT required. During the first year, you will receive training to obtain them, while being paid to do so.

- ✘ Notification pager is provided
- ✘ Worker's Compensation Insurance
- ✘ Life and Disability Insurance

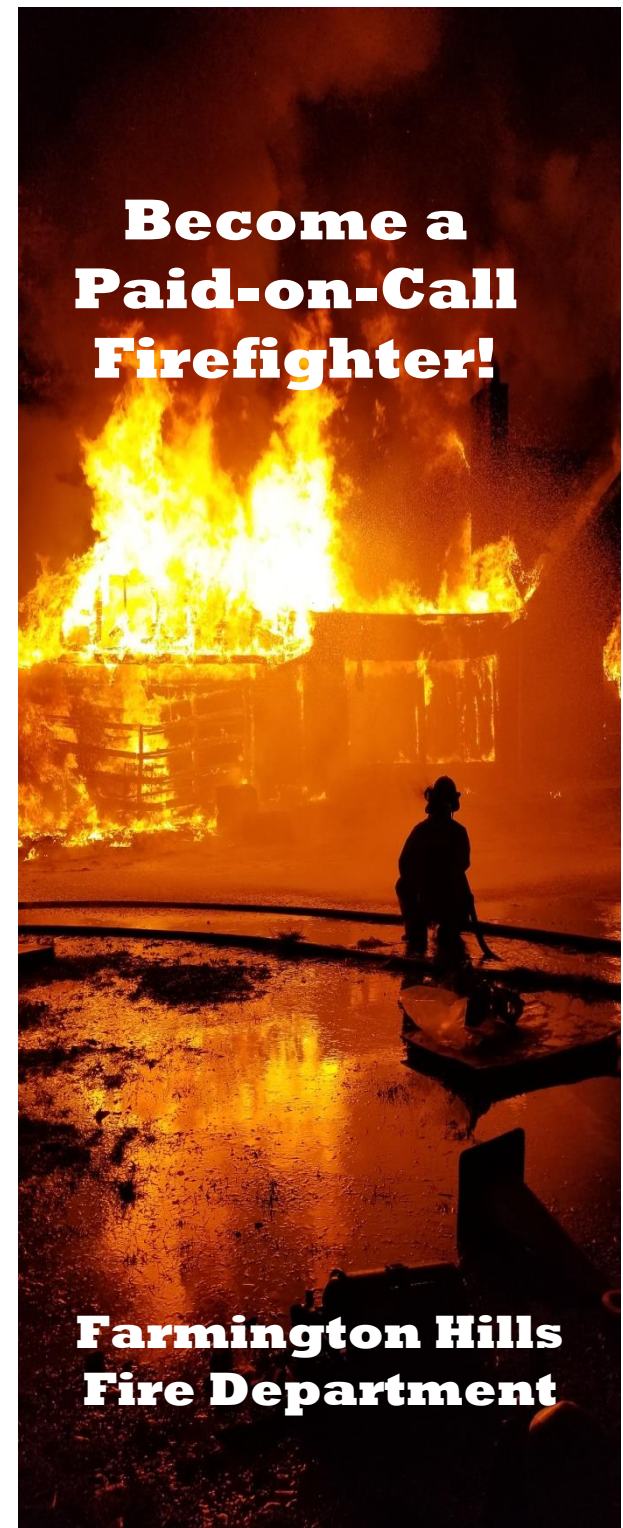

Picture yourself becoming a vital member of one of the best Fire Departments in Michigan. The highly acclaimed Farmington Hills Fire Department (FHFD) is a premier organization featuring exemplary members, state-of-the-art equipment, and a competitive pay rate.

The FHFD is seeking Paid-on-Call (POC)/Part-Time Firefighters to provide emergency services to their community. POC Firefighters respond to their station when a 911 call occurs in their response district at night and throughout the weekends. The majority of the calls (64%) are EMS related, followed by motor vehicle accidents and then fire related calls.

As a POC Firefighter, you will have the opportunity to participate in public education events that take place in the stations, schools, and public parks. Every year Department members look forward to participating in the Founder's Day and Memorial Day parades.

Firefighters share a special bond that goes beyond friendship. Come and join our family and enjoy the benefits of genuine support.



FIRE SUPPRESSION

Knowledge gained through rigorous training and live burn training gives Paid-on-Call Fire Fighters the experience and confidence to rescue occupants while confining and extinguishing fires.



After being assigned to a station, POC Fire Fighters join a "family" with traditions and plenty of stories to go around. Each station gets together for monthly training, yearly parties, and other events that build comradery. Popular Department-wide events (not all are Department sponsored) include a hockey and softball team. Each station has a gym for members who like to work out. Every year small groups of Department members participate in the "Fight for Air Climb," and other obstacle course runs.



TRAINING

The FHFD will provide the necessary training to become a Fire Fighter and EMT-B. You ***do not*** need to have these certifications or license as the FHFD will provide the training for you to obtain them.

The Firefighter and EMT-B programs are held two nights each week from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., and on Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. During training you will be paid for attending class.



SHIFT WORK

Upon successful completion of your training and probationary period, optional shift work is available. Available shifts are 6 hours, 10.5 hours, or 13.5 hours. You are able to choose these optional shifts to fit your schedule. You will also have the opportunity to assist with training new recruits in the program you just completed.
