Farmington Hills Police Investigating Single Vehicle Fatal crash on Eight Mile Road

*The motorcycle crash occurred early Monday morning, near the
intersection of Eight Mile Road and Metroview Road*

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. (May 20, 2024) – The Farmington Hills Police Department is investigating a single vehicle fatal crash that occurred early Monday morning near the intersection of Eight Mile Road and Metroview Road. The Department responded at approximately 5:50 a.m., after a woman called 911 to report that after she observed a crashed motorcycle near the baseball fields of the Founders Sports Park, she turned around to check for the driver, who appeared to be deceased when she located him near the crash site. Officers arrived on location moments later, along with firefighter/paramedics from the Farmington Hills Fire Department, who confirmed the motorcycle driver was deceased on scene.

Farmington Hills Police traffic investigators are on scene investigating the crash and attempting to notify the next of kin of the deceased driver. At this time, it is unclear whether alcohol or drugs may be a factor. The investigation shows that the driver was not wearing a helmet at the time of the crash. Eight Mile Road reopened shortly after 10 a.m. Monday.
