## FPS 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Science Unit – Feature Factor

The Farmington Hills Nature Center is excited to offer **self-guided nature walks connected to your child's current science unit!** Programs are designed in partnership with FPS science teachers to support classroom learning outcomes. Enjoy the beauty of nature and enhance your child's learning!

Use the provided map to take a nature walk along the Heritage Park trails, stopping at the spots marked with a red star. Encourage your child to be a detective and think about what they're learning in science class: **How do the body parts of plants and animals help them survive?** 

Bring a pencil so your student can **record their observations and discoveries** (or write the evidence when you get home). After, consider stopping by the Nature Center (during open hours) to see our live animals and exhibits.

START: Follow the Nature Discovery Trail, starting at the entrance near the Nature Center ( on the Map). Stop along the way to look closely for <u>evidence</u> of how the body parts of plants and animals help them survive: <u>Camouflage, Seeds, Tails, Wings, and Nests!</u>


