## City Conducts Cannabis Conversations Public Outreach and Education Sessions to Be Held October 3 & 4

The City of Farmington Hills will host two Cannabis Conversations to share details from recent information gathering efforts and to allow Farmington Hills residents and business community members to voice their opinions and concerns.

In order to learn more about the cannabis industry, City Administration recently met with leaders from other municipalities that have allowed commercial production and sales of both medical and recreational cannabis. City officials also conducted information gathering sessions with commercial cannabis industry representatives to gain insight about production and retail distribution now that Michigan has legalized both medical and recreational cannabis.

The Cannabis Conversations are open to all members of the public and will take place live in the Council Chambers at Farmington Hills City Hall located at 31555 W. Eleven Mile Road. Both public feedback sessions will also be livestreamed via YouTube on the following dates:

- Session #1 Monday, October 3 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.
- Session #2 Tuesday, October 4 9:00 to 11:00 a.m.
