## **Community Service**

You have been ordered by the court to complete \_\_\_\_ hours of community service. The deadline will be determined by your assigned probation officer.

- 1. Community service must be completed at a non-profit organization. A list with suggested agencies is provided. If you choose an agency that is not listed or you are not sure if the agency is non-profit, ask your probation officer before you start volunteering. You may work for more than one agency.
- 2. A log sheet is provided to keep track of your hours, but it is not required to fill out. After the hours are completed, you must provide a letter <u>on the agency's letterhead stationery</u> to your probation officer. The letter must include the following:
  - Number of hours worked
  - Work performed
  - Name, signature, and phone number of the person that can verify the hours volunteered
  - 501(c)(3) tax identification number
- 3. It is your responsibility to provide the letter to your probation officer. It may be emailed, faxed, mailed, or dropped off in person at the court for credit.
