EDUCATION:	Applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
SPECIAL SKILLS & TRAINING:	Possess a valid Michigan Operator's license and must obtain a Class A Commercial Driver's License with air brake and tank endorsements within 120 days of the date of hire. Applicant must have basic computer skills in word processing and spreadsheet software, basic skills navigating a computer operating system and applications. Applicant must also have a Commercial Pesticide Application license category 6 & 3b or able to obtain one within 120 days of the hire date.
BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES:	Work is performed under the direction of road maintenance supervisors and senior equipment operators in all weather conditions. Duties include construction and road repair, roadside landscaping, litter control, storm drain repairs, forestry maintenance, repair of traffic signs, and snow/ice control. Overtime is required for snowstorms, ice storms, and other emergencies.
