Collaborate with Camp Instructors to plan and lead engaging activities, ensuring a well-rounded and diverse program. Facilitate group discussions and encourage camper participation. · Create and implement weekly lesson plans for educational and recreational activities. **Archery Activities:** Actively participate in Archery activities with campers, ensuring their safety and enjoyment. Provide supervision during archery shooting and safety sessions. Assist in organizing and implementing games and activities for campers waiting their turn to shoot. **Lesson Planning:** Develop creative and age-appropriate lesson plans for various camp activities, ensuring they align with camp goals and objectives. • Integrate educational elements into activities, fostering both learning and fun. Team Collaboration: Work collaboratively with fellow camp counselors and staff to coordinate daily activities and ensure a seamless camp experience.
