### POINTS OF INTEREST/UPDATES:

Cemetery Sub-Committee

Commissioners Olson and Trafelet reported on a meeting with City Staff Karen Mondora, Kevin McCarthy and Staff Liaison Lawrence. The HDC provided overview of the cemetery conditions and draft list of priorities for discussion (via PPT). Chair Klemmer and Commissioner Trafelet to re-visit the West Cemetery to advise on landscape maintenance requiring immediate attention (tree and brush trimming). Commissioners Olson and Trafelet to start process of developing a scope, potentially working with a consultant (with expertise in cemetery preservation), to produce a Master Plan, multi-year budget, recommendation on potential for obtaining grants, and determining

#### **NEW BUSINESS**:

A. CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS 19-9 - HISTORIC DISTRICT #7 DAVID SIMMONS HOUSE

Request to replace all nine (9) windows in the rear and repair all windows in the front of the structure presented with drawings (dated Oct 23, 2019). Brian Winkleman, project architect was reached and questioned via phone.

Considerable discussion focused on clarifying points of confusion: are windows double hung (functional/moveable) or fixed, placement of on the drawings (upper window placement on the South elevation, level of windows on the lower level relative to the roof line), etc. Commissioner Paulson provided photos which helped clarify current appearance of the house.

Motion for repair of existing historic windows on front / North elevation and replacement of the nine (9) windows in the rear / South elevation. The new windows on the South main pedimented section to match to originals (on the North elevation) in size and placement.

Approval is conditional, dependent on the HDC receiving revised drawings, to reflect historic placement for the upper windows in the pedimented section, and correct window schedule and specs. Historic front door to be replaced to meet commercial code; spec to be provided to HDC.
