Nominations are now being accepted for property owners who go above and beyond to create and maintain beautiful landscapes, thereby enhancing the City of Farmington Hills. Nominations are open now and **due by June 25, 2024, with judging taking place in early July 2024.**

Awards are presented annually to businesses, offices, places of worship, shopping centers, and subdivision and condominium entrances with attractive and well-maintained landscapes. Judges from the Beautification Commission will visit nominated sites in early July to look for well-planned design, landscape variety, imaginative use of color, originality and property maintenance.
